



Quick Summary

Army Emergency Relief is a private non-profit organization incorporated in 1942 to provide financial assistance to Soldiers, active and retired, and their Families. Since AER's founding over 3.4 million Soldiers and their Families have received more than \$1.4 billion in support from Army Emergency Relief.

2011 Program Results

- **Financial Assistance**
 - Provided \$69.4 million in No-Interest Loans and Grants to relieve financial distress to 62,000 Soldiers and their Families for a wide range of needs to include rent, food, vehicle repair and travel expenses
 - Distributed 545 grants for health and comfort items to medically evacuated Wounded Warriors
 - Enrolled 221 Survivors of Fallen Soldiers in lifetime benefits counseling
- **Educational Assistance**
 - Granted \$8.1 million to help meet undergraduate education needs
 - Provided 3,185 scholarships to children of Soldiers
 - Provided 1,166 scholarships to spouses of Soldiers
